The Committee calls on the Government to develop clear guidance on the human rights obligations of private probation providers, and to set out how it will monitor the performance of the contracted providers in this regard

Presently, the IMF staff recommends a waiver on the basis of the authorities' commitment to prevent any reoccurrence.
