relating to criminal liability for encouraging or assisting another person to commit an offence. There are currently three inchoate offences in common law which seek to punish conduct which enhances the prospect of actual harm occurring (relating to: attempt, conspiracy and incitement) but no inchoate offence to cover assisting a person to commit an offence if subsequently the offence is not committed or attempted.
